- Cesidian political science General Rule Number Two: you are hated by "something" — eg, a nation, a town, or a state — if that something is two orders of magnitude (two Tallini Worlds, and there are six altogether) less developed than your something — ie a nation, a town, or a state (real nations, or Fifth World nations, are usually hated by non-polities, wannabe polities, or observers ["7th world" stuff], to use UN lingo; Third World nations are usually hated by real parishes, nations or tribes [Fifth World nations], and in turn often hate First World nations)
